**LISTEN TO AND HEED HIS CALL**



The Fourth Sunday of Easter is "Good Shepherd Sunday." The Gospel reading, albeit very short, clearly points out that Jesus Christ is our Good Shepherd and that all of us should listen to and heed His call.

In the first reading, Paul, and Barnabas take upon themselves the responsibility of preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the Jews. These two disciples emphasize the need for listening first to the Gospel before preaching it to the people.

Indeed, we must first listen to the call and respond to it before we let other people listen and respond to God's invitation. If we ourselves are attentive to the voice of the Shepherd, we can be assured that people will follow us because of our witnessing of God's call.

In our society today, it is very difficult to listen. Mostly will claim to have all the solutions to all problems that confront us. We have the tendency to talk too much and forget to listen to others. Hence, we are reminded once again that if we want to share in the joy of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, we must be able to always listen to the voice of God.

How can we listen to God's voice? First, let us make it a point to read the Sacred Scriptures. We can pray to Him in silence so we can hear His voice within us. But it is very important that we persevere because there are times when our prayers seem unanswered but it does not mean that God does not listen to our prayers. **Happy Mother's Day!**





**SUNDAY MASS READINGS**

**1st Readings—Acts 13: 14, 43-52**

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

Paul and Barnabas carried on from Perga till they reached Antioch in Pisidia. Here they went to synagogue on the sabbath and took their seats. When the meeting broke up, many Jews and devout converts joined Paul and Barnabas, and in their talks with them Paul and Barnabas urged them to remain faithful to the grace God had given them. The next sabbath almost the whole town assembled to hear the word of God. When they saw the crowds, the Jews, prompted by jealousy, used blasphemies and contradicted everything Paul said. Then Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, 'We had to proclaim the word of God to you first, but since you have rejected it, since you do not think yourselves worthy of eternal life, we must turn to the pagans. For this is what the Lord commanded us to do when he said: I have made you a light for the nations, so that my salvation may reach the ends of the earth.' It made the pagans very happy to hear this and they thanked the Lord for his message; all who were destined for eternal life became believers. Thus the word of the Lord spread through the whole countryside. But the Jews worked upon some of the devout women of the upper classes and the leading men of the city and persuaded them to turn against Paul and Barnabas and expel them from their territory. So they shook the dust from their feet in defiance and went off to Iconium; but the disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit. **The Word of the Lord**

**2nd Reading Rev 7: 9, 14-17**

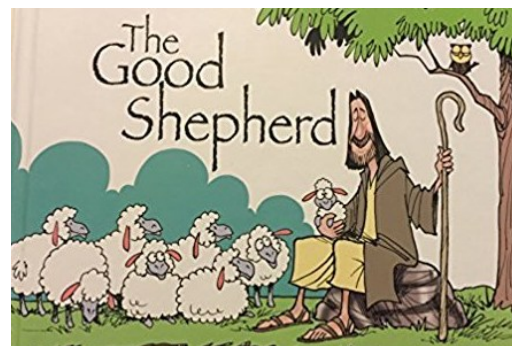
A reading from the book of Revelation
